

MINUTES

DANBURY TOWN COUNCIL

JULY 28, 2010

The regular meeting of the Danbury Town Council was held at the Danbury Town Hall on July 28, 2010 at 7:00 p.m.

Present were Mayor Janet Whitt, Andrew Mathys, Mike Barsness, Wendi Uselton, Olivia Shelton, Town Administrator Byron Ellis, Town Attorney Mike Bruce, Town Clerk Dianne Starnes.

Mayor Whitt called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

On motion of Andrew Mathys, seconded by Wendi Uselton, it was unanimously

RESOLVED that the agenda be amended to add discussion of a legal matter in closed session.

On motion of Olivia Shelton, seconded by Wendi Uselton, it was unanimously

RESOLVED that the agenda be amended to add a discussion on personal care items needed by the skilled nursing unit at Stokes Reynolds Hospital.

On motion of Wendi Uselton, seconded by Olivia Shelton, it was unanimously

RESOLVED that the agenda be accepted as amended.

RESOLVED that the minutes for the regular meeting of June 23, 2010 and the minutes of a special meeting held on July 12, 2010 be approved.

RESOLVED that a fee not be charged for participating in the Stokes Stomp Parade this year, but will discuss and consider charging for 2011 parade.

RESOLVED that a discussion on civil penalties for ordinance violations be tabled and added to the August 25, 2010 agenda under old business.

On motion of Olivia Shelton, seconded by Wendi Uselton, it was unanimously

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RESOLVED that the Town of Danbury supports, and will participate in, the preliminary and exploratory phases of a project which may lead to the development of a unified Stokes County Land Use Plan.

Town Administrator Byron Ellis presented a construction proposal (for an addition to the Town Hall) to the Council for discussion.

RESOLVED that the Town donate \$100.00 to the skilled nursing unit at Stokes Reynolds Hospital to buy soap and lotions.

RESOLVED that Council go into closed session at 7:55 p.m. to discuss a legal matter.
