DANBURY TOWN COUNCIL

MAY 22, 2013

A regular meeting of the Danbury Town Council was held at the Danbury Public Library on May 22, 2013 at 7:00 p.m.

Present were Mayor Janet Whitt; Council Members Ken Carrick, Gary East, Wendi Spraker and Olivia Shelton; Town Administrator Mike Barsness, Town Clerk Dianne Starnes and Town Attorney Mike Bruce.

Mayor Whitt called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

On motion of Ken Carrick, seconded by Gary East, it was unanimously

RESOLVED that the agenda be approved as submitted.

Councilmember comments – Wendi Spraker asked that limbs overhanging on King Circle be looked at. Olivia Shelton expressed as interest in wifi for Danbury. Town Administrator said he would look into it.

On motion of Wendi Spraker, seconded by Olivia Shelton, it was unanimously

RESOLVED that the minutes of the April 24, 2013 meeting be approved.

On motion of Gary East, seconded by Olivia Shelton, it was unanimously

RESOLVED that Accounts Payable for April 24, 2013 through May 22, 2013 be approved as submitted.

Mayor Whitt opened the 2013 – 2014 Budget Public Hearing at 7:07 p.m. There were no comments from the general public. The Mayor closed the Public Hearing at 7:08 p.m.

RESOLVED that Waste Industries be approved for garbage and recycling collection services, contingent upon completion of acceptable contract terms.

RESOLVED that Eddie's Paving and patching be approved for repairs to three town storm drain covers.

On motion of Ken Carrick, seconded by Gary East, it was unanimously

RESOLVED that NCDOT be approved to repair and overlay Crestview Road.

RESOLVED that the Town contract with Rouse, Rouse, Penn and Rouse, LLP to audit accounts for the period beginning July 1, 2012 and ending June 30, 2013.

Administrator's Report –

2. Streetscape has been weeded and mulched.
3. Minor trimming of trees will continue over the summer as time allows.
