The Parade sponsored by the Town of Danbury will be held this year on **Saturday, September 14, 2024**
at **10:00 A.M.**

The parade begins at the Stokes County Government Center and will proceed on Main Street to Moratock Park.

Line-up/staging, **EXCEPT Marching Bands**, will happen at the Government Center on Saturday morning beginning at **8:00 A.M.** *Restrooms will be available in the lobby of the Stokes County Corrections Center.*

Marching Bands will stage on Sheep Rock Road beginning at **9:00 A. M.**
Restrooms will be available in the Stokes County Offices at that location.

Judging of entries will occur between 8:15 A.M. and 9:15 A.M and awards will be presented from 9:30 A.M. to 10:00 A.M. **Only entries arriving before 8:30 A.M. will be eligible for awards.**

The parade will get underway promptly at 10:00 A.M. *(It is imperative that the parade start on time and proceed without stopping or delay - the only highway through Danbury is being closed for our event.)*
